

Where Do YOU Buy Groceries??

The following list includes many of the grocery stores in this area. Please use this list to see how YOU can earn money for our school by shopping at the stores you already purchase from.

Albertsons - Sign up for a Preferred Savings Card at the store. Then register your card number in the school office. Each time you check out, hand this card to the cashier. When they scan the card, Hillcrest will get up to **4%** of the total of your order. If you already have a Hillcrest Community Partners card, have the cashier scan both cards at the beginning of your order. The two cards will then be “linked”. (you will know that the cards are linked when your receipt says “thank you for supporting our schools”).

Vons – Register your Vons Club card with e-Scrip online at www.eScrip.com. Our Group ID # is 5620795. After your card is registered, each time you scan it at the checkout counter they will donate up to **5%** of your order to Hillcrest. If you do not know your Vons Club # (if you use your phone # at checkout) You may call 877-723-3929 and they will give you your club #.)

Ralphs - Register your Ralphs card number with the Hillcrest front office. If you use your keychain tag, it is that tiny little number on the bottom. If you use your phone number and do not know your club card number, call 800-660-9003 and they will be able to give you your number. Ralphs donates up to **5%** to Hillcrest.

Gelsons – Buy SCRIP! One US dollar is equal to one dollar of Scrip. Purchase Gelsons Scrip every Thursday in the parking lot or buy it anytime in the Finance Office. Gelsons uses paper Scrip. It is sold in \$10, \$25, \$50 denominations. Use it like you would use cash in their store. Gelsons gives Hillcrest **5%** of all of your purchases! If this is your “regular” grocery store, this is a great way to make a big donation to the school without spending any extra money!

Smart N Final – Buy SCRIP! One US dollar is equal to one dollar of Scrip. Purchase Smart N Final Scrip in the parking lot every Thursday. Or buy it in the Finance Office any time. Smart N Final uses prepaid gift cards. They are sold in \$25 and \$50 denominations. Use it like you would use a “gift card”. Hillcrest gets **3%** of your purchase.

Bristol Farms – Register your Debit/Credit card with e-Scrip. Go to www.eScrip.com and register with their secure site online. e-Scrip means = “electronic Scrip”. When you use your Debit/Credit card at a participating e-Scrip store, our school “electronically” gets the money. Bristol Farms is an e-Scrip merchant. They donate up to **7%** of your order total to Hillcrest. You must pay with the credit/debit card/s registered with e-Scrip in order for Hillcrest to get the donation.

Whole Foods – Buy SCRIP! One US dollar is equal to one dollar of Scrip. Purchase Whole Foods Scrip every Thursday in the Parking lot or buy it in the Finance Office any time. Whole Foods uses prepaid gift cards. They are sold in \$50 denominations. Hillcrest gets **5%** of your purchase.

Trader Joes – Unfortunately, Trader Joes does not participate in any cash-back to schools program. We will let you know if this changes in the future. We do, however, thank them for their very generous merchandise donations that they make to our Annual Golf Tournament and Auction each year.

Celebrity Prime Foods - This company was brought to our attention by one of our Hillcrest Family members who has used its services for many years. This is a Nationwide Grocery company that provides top quality food and delivers it to your home. Products are hormone and pesticide free. Their claim is that their prices are in line with Costco. Celebrity Prime has offered our school a wonderful deal. Each family that fills out the information sheet and makes an appointment to hear about Celebrity Prime Foods will earn \$20 for Hillcrest. They will make the donation, whether you sign up with them or not! And, if you like what you see and sign up for their program YOU will receive a weeks groceries for FREE!
